

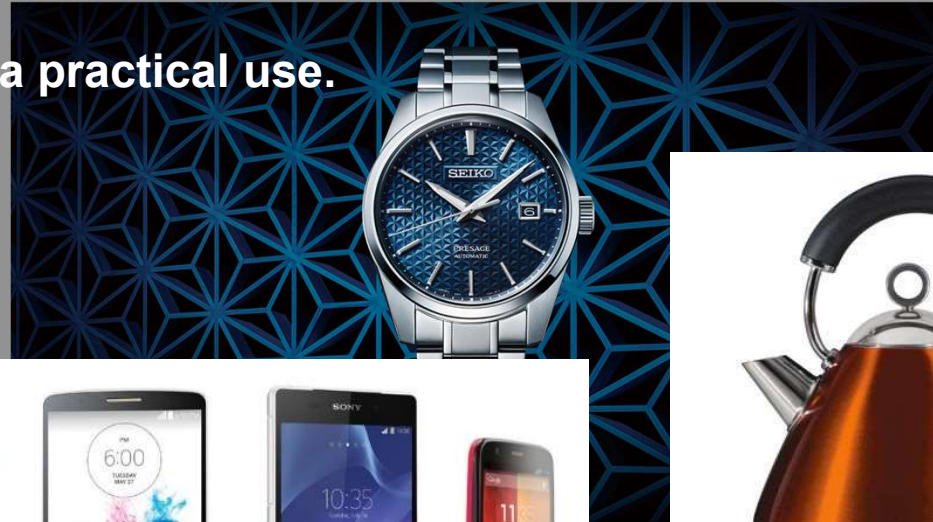

**APPLIED ART ...art that has a practical use.**

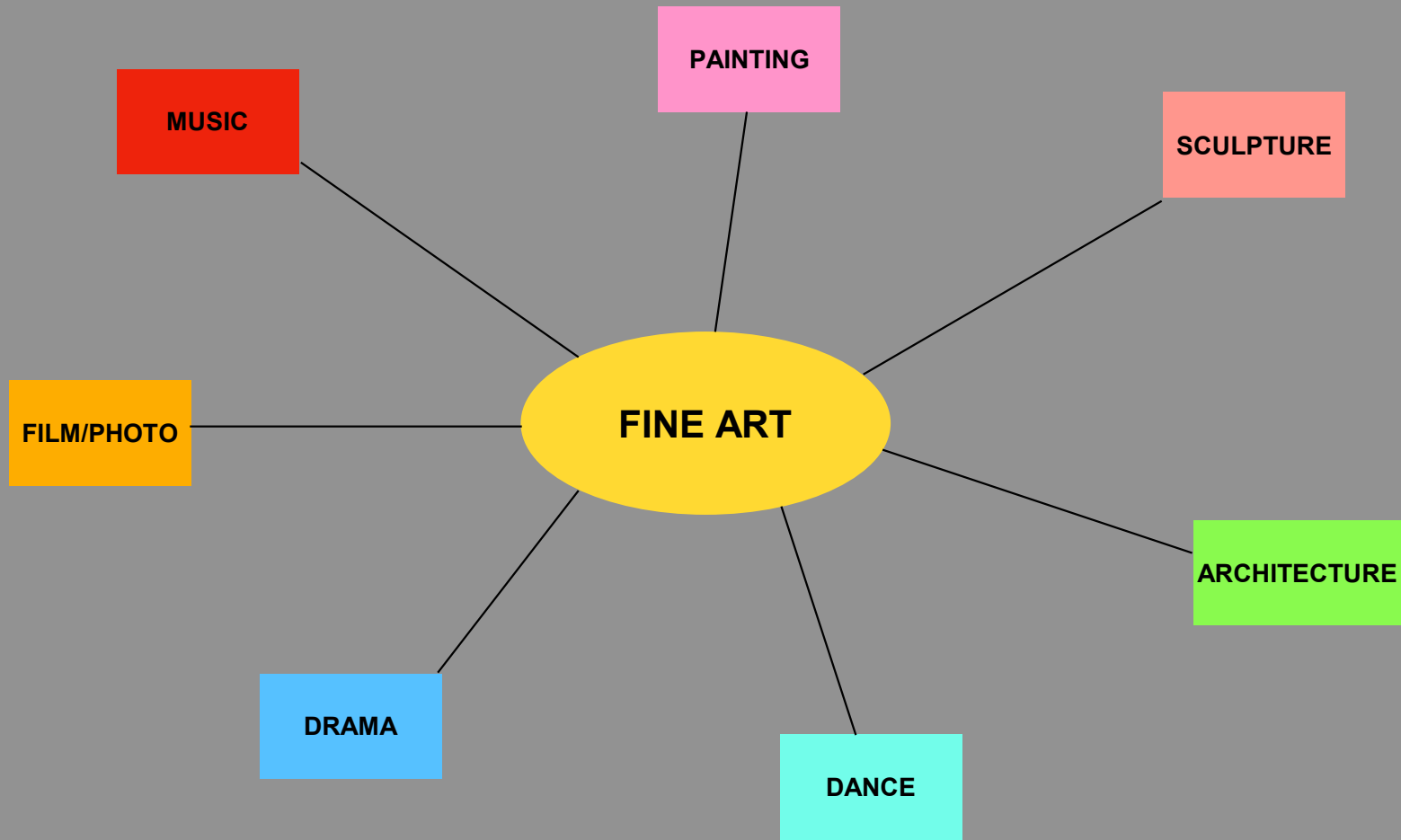
