Portrait photography is aimed toward capturing the personality of a person by using effective lighting, backdrops, and poses. Human subjects only.

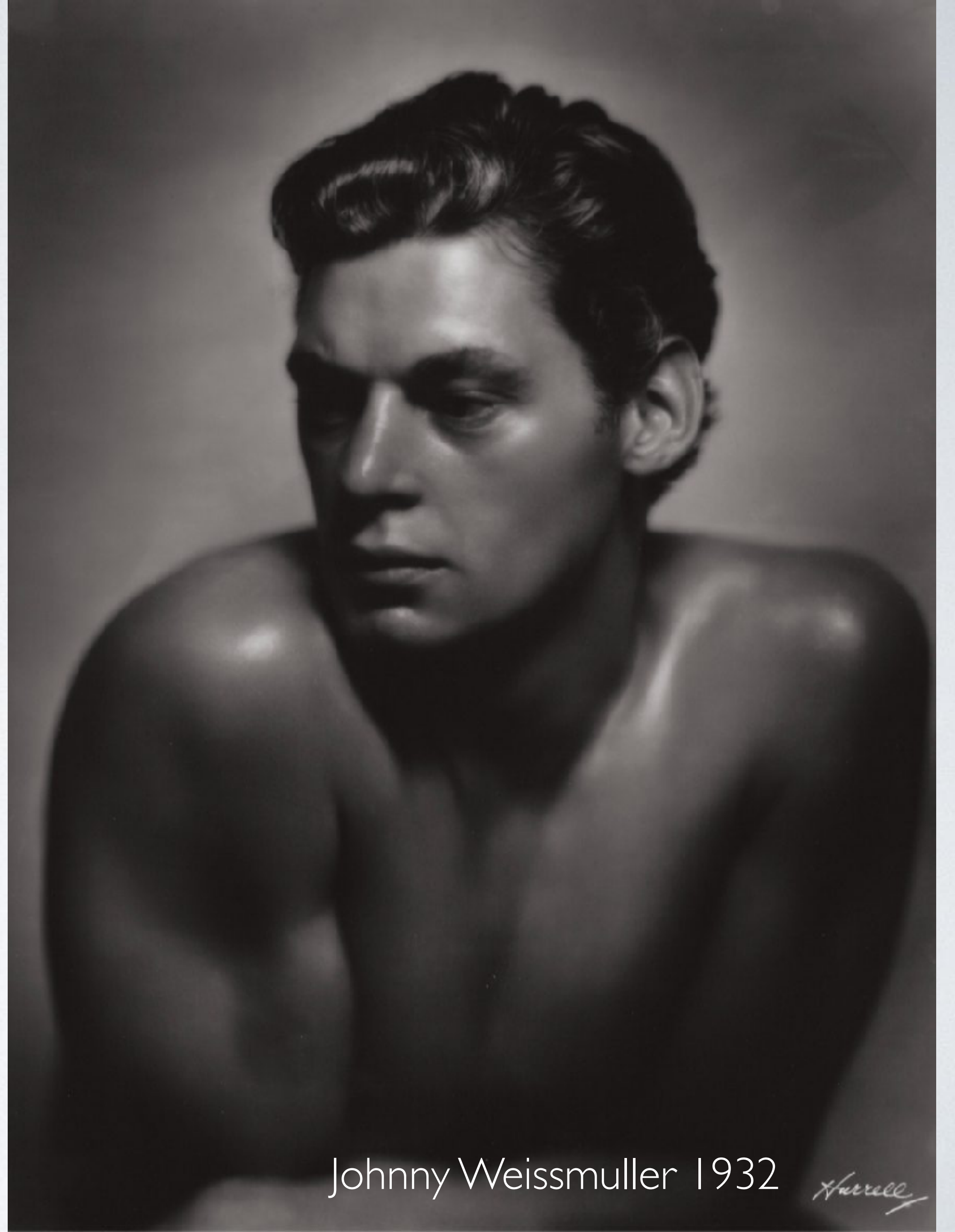
