

Competition definitions 2026/2027

Reflections - Utilise a reflective surface to create a visually interesting composition. Regardless of the genre, use the reflection to add depth or intrigue to your images. The reflection must not be software-generated.

Monochrome photography – Black and white plus all the shades of grey on any subject you choose.

Portrait photography – Capturing the personality of a person. From head/shoulders, to person in their environment. No animal portraits.

Mobile phone/tablet photography – Any genre of photography but all elements or images must have been photographed on a mobile or tablet device.

Minimalist photography – Simple, uncluttered image with limited colour palette.

Low light/night photography – Capturing images in dimly lit conditions, using long exposure format.

Macro photography – Close up photography that magnifies tiny subjects. Capturing intricate details often missed by the naked eye.
